



UK & EU GDPR – INFORMATION NOTICE ON PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

(Article 13 UK GDPR and Article 13 Regulation (EU) 2016/679)

In accordance with art 13 UK GDPR and art. 13, UE Regulation n. 2016/679 (GDPR), GVS Filter Technology UK Limited informs of the following:

1. Controller of the data processing (art. 13, par. 1 a). 1. The Controller of the data processing is GVS Filter Technology UK Limited, Company number 02647901, Miguel Aranda, Managing Director, Caton Road, Lancaster LA1 3PE – United Kingdom.
 2. Purposes of the processing (art. 13, par. 1 c). The Purpose of the processing is the carrying out the obligations of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract.
 3. Legal basis (art. 13, par. 1 c). The contractual relations, described above, constitute the legal basis of the processing of data.
 4. Recipients of the personal data (art. 13, par. 1 e). Recipients are GVS employees of the Purchasing Office, for Suppliers' data, and Customer Service Office, for Clients' data. Possibly addresses are the employees of GVS group for the fulfilment of the contract.
 5. Transfer of personal data to a third country (art. 13, par. 1 f). GVS could transfer data abroad to GVS Group's Societies and for purposes related to the fulfilment of the contract, the implementation of pre-contractual measures taken at the data subject's request and, anyway, in compliance with the UK and EU GDPR (art. 49, par. 1, b, c, where applicable).
 6. Period of storage (art. 13, par. 2 a). The period for which the personal data will be stored is 10 years after the termination of the contractual relation.
 7. Data subject's rights (art. 13, par. 2 b). Data subjects can exercising their rights granted by the UK GDPR and EU GDPR Regulation. The rights are the following: right to the present information (art. 13); right to access (art. 15); right to rectification (art. 16); right to erasure (art. 17); right to restriction of processing (art. 18); right to object (art. 21). The data subjects can exercise these rights (and all the other provided by Regulation) by request sent to privacy@gvs.it or registered letter, attested by an acknowledgment of receipt, to GVS PRIVACY c/o GVS S.p.a., Via Roma 50, Zola Predosa (BO) Italy. In case of no answer, the data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (art. 13, par. 2 d).
 8. Necessary requirement of personal data provision (art. 13, par. 2 e). The processing of personal data is a contractual obligation. The consequence of failure to provide such data leads to the practical impossibility to carry on the contract.
 9. Automated decision-making (art. 13, par. 2 f). GVS UK does not adopt automated decision-making.
